ERAIFT took part in the third training session on the project management cycle in Central Africa,

organised by CIFOR-ICRAF in Brazzaville, from 15 to 19 May 2023.

From 15 to 19 May 2023, ERAIFT participated in Brazzaville (Republic of Congo) in the third training session on the project management cycle in Central Africa, organised by the Centre for International Forestry Research and the International Centre for Research in Agroforestry (CIFOR-ICRAF), within the framework of the RESSAC programme (applied research in ecology and social sciences) funded by the European Union.

This training session brought together twenty-four participants, including university researchers, members of civil society and public administration executives, from four countries in the COMIFAC region, namely the Democratic Republic of Congo, the Republic of Congo, Burundi and Cameroon. ERAIFT was represented by Research Assistant Charles Mumbere Musavandalo.

The aim of this regional workshop is to strengthen the capacities of scientific researchers, protected area managers, public administration executives, agro-industrial operators and members of civil society so that they can focus their research work on operational solutions and, consequently, mobilise more funding for the sustainable management of natural resources in the Congo basin.

In total, six modules were shared and discussed during this training session, including: project identification, feasibility study, project/programme formulation, project structuring, risk analysis and drafting a concept note. At the end of the training, the participants requested the support of CIFOR-ICRAF and SETYM International in the formulation of the projects proposed by the working groups.
