



ERAIFT Masters students in Management of Protected Areas and Biosphere Reserves (GAP/GRB) in regional study mobility at the « Ecole de faune de Garoua »/ Garoua Wildlife school semester 3: from July to December 2022.

Since 29 June 2022, 17 students of the 3rd ERAIFT Master's class from 6 sub-Saharan African countries (DRC, CAR, Benin, Chad, Niger, Republic of Congo) are at the "Ecole de Faune de Garoua (EFG, Cameroon)" to specialize in Protected Areas Management and Biosphere Reserves Management (GAP/GRB).

The practical training is organized within the framework of the operationalization of the 3rd Semester of specialization of the students in various fields of biodiversity and environmental management, and which is spread over a period of 6 months, from July 1st to December 31st, 2022. Students spent the first two semesters at ERAIFT learning the fundamentals of the systems approach.

The objective of this practical training is to place the learners in a real situation of conservation, in order to increase their knowledge of the complexity of the management of protected areas and biosphere reserves. While in Cameroon, the students will carry out several activities related to their specialization, including documentary research, laboratory work, field training, several scientific field visits in the various parks and biosphere reserves of Cameroon. They will benefit from the experiences of the managers of protected areas and biosphere reserves in Cameroon. This learning-by-doing will make these future African managers professional enough to respond to the various challenges of nature conservation.
